ADNICH Workshop series in Albania

The workshops organized in the framework of the project ADNICH were conceptualized to be logically and artistically linked with the situation of the self-locked children, victims of the blood feud in Albania.

For this reason, Qendra EVENT made a preliminary analysis in order to increase the effect of its intervention, trying to reach different segments of the society, victims of the isolated life within the conditions of blood feud.

Shkodra was one of the cities, where Qendra EVENT organized in an unusual way the workshop dedicated to children from 3 to 12 years old. This activity was conceptualized to be a Muppet theatre to better find the way of communication with these kids.
